The PricePedia platform (<u>www.pricepedia.it</u>), developed by **StudiaBo srl**, is dedicated to those working in the world of procurement and sourcing, acting as a provider of reliable and constantly updated information, to be used as a benchmark in corporate purchasing processes. PricePedia combines data from various sources, gathered from actual transactions, about the price development of commodities and semi-finished products, presented in tabular form and interactive data visualisation. Navigation of the information is clear and modern, while retaining the analytical functionality typical of business intelligence.



PricePedia collects daily data of prices quoted on financial markets around the world and records the monthly price trends of over 700 raw materials and semi-finished products. The prices on the platform are based exclusively on objective data, derived from a large sample of actual transactions: financial markets and customs surveys of the 27 EU countries. Over 3000 historical series are available on the platform including: customs prices of commodities and semi-finished products, quoted financial prices, economic variables and scenario indicators.

Basic subscription

To monitor daily financial prices (spot, futures, continuous) of 100+commodities.



One subscription

To monitor the financial and physical prices on the European market of individual product families.



One Plus subscription

To monitor and **predict** the financial and physical prices on the European market of individual product families.



All subscription

To monitor both financial (almost 100 commodities) and physical (over 500 raw materials and commodities) prices of all commodity families on the European market.



All Plus subscription

To monitor and **predict** the financial and physical prices on the European market of all product families.

To monitor and **predict** the financial and physical prices on the International markets of all product families and to integrate PricePedia data directly into the company information system.

1. Subscriptions

PricePedia subscriptions can be directly purchased on the platform website and last a full year (365 days) from the activation of the service.


1.1 Basic

The *Basic* subscription provides access to the following sections of the PricePedia platform:

- US Producer Prices^{*}
- Conjunctural Indicators*
- **US Customs** (Monthly prices obtained from the USA trade flows)
- China Customs (Monthly prices obtained from the Chinese trade flows)
- Download Data Tool*

Daily Data Prices

Daily Data Prices is the dataset that contains the daily prices of **over 120 commodities listed on the main commodity exchanges worldwide** (London Metal Exchange, Chicago Mercantile Exchange, Shanghai Future Exchange, etc.) and other daily indicators developed by PricePedia to account for the dynamics observed in financial markets.




The dataset allows daily monitoring of historical series for different price measures and various maturities (both futures contracts and continuous contracts).

DataViz: Price Heatmap




Daily Data Country



The price of the Daily Data Country dataset is 100€ + VAT.




World Bank Forecast



Twice a year, the World Bank releases its own **Outlook** on the future price prospects of major commodities. In PricePedia, it is possible to monitor this data and compare it with other historical series.


PricePedia Aggregated Indices



The aggregated PricePedia indices are indices built by aggregating products belonging to a specific commodity category. The weight of each product within the index is assigned based on import values.




Conjunctural Indicators



The Conjunctural *Indicators* dataset collects some of the main economic indices: PMI indices for major geographical areas; economic activity indices (Industrial Production Index, etc.); consumer prices for the Euro Area and the USA; Europe gas inventories.

The price of the Conjunctural Indicators dataset is 100€ + VAT.

EU Producer Prices




The EU Producer Prices dataset allows monitoring of average production price indices for the European market. The indices, sourced from Eurostat, are classified by production activity identified by Ateco.

The price of the EU Producer Prices dataset is 100€ + VAT.



US Producer Prices




The US Producer Prices dataset allows monitoring of average production price indices for the U.S. market. The indices are compiled by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and are organized according to two classifications: the first by industry (identified by the NAICS code) and the second by commodity.

The price of the US Producer Prices dataset is 100€ + VAT.

US Customs

The *US Customs* dataset contains monthly prices processed by PricePedia based on U.S. foreign trade flows, both imports and exports. The dataset includes the price measure **History USA**.




The History USA measure allows the analysis of the monthly dynamics of price series. It refers to the average prices calculated exclusively using U.S. customs declarations, for imports (CIF prices) and exports (FOB prices), providing the highest degree of objectivity.




China Customs

The *China Customs* dataset contains monthly prices processed by PricePedia based on China's foreign trade flows, both imports and exports. The reference measure is **History China**.



The History China measure allows the analysis of the **monthly dynamics** of price series. It refers to the average prices calculated exclusively using China's customs declarations, for imports (CIF prices) and exports (FOB prices), providing the **highest degree of objectivity**.

Download Data Tool



The Download Data tool allows to download up to 99 historical series of interest simultaneously in a single Excel file.

The price of the Download Data Tool is 100€ + VAT.

Basic subscription price

The price of the *Basic* subscription is 990€ + VAT.



1.2 One

In addition to integrating the sections already described for the *Basic* subscription, the *One*subscription grants access to the following sections related to customs prices for**one** or **multiple specific commodity categories of interest**:

• **EU Customs** (Monthly prices obtained from the trade flows of EU countries)

EU Customs

The following price measures are contained within the EU Customs section:

- Last Price EU (Contracts price referred to the observation month)
- Last Price EU not revised (Contracts price referred to the observation month, without further modifications in the time series historical values)
- **History EU** (Historical dynamics of commodity prices)
- **Dispersion EU** (Monthly price dispersion)


Last Price EU



The Last Price EU measure allows you to analyze the monthly dynamics of one or more price series (which fall within the chosen product families), providing the maximum of data update. Last Price can be used as a **negotiation** tool with suppliers. In fact, it contains the prices associated with the negotiations and contracts that took place in a specific month.




Last Price EU not revised



The Last Price EU not revised measure, like Last Price EU, allows you to analyze the monthly dynamics of one or more price series. The difference between these two measures stands in the fact that Last Price EU not revised incorporates the information related only to the last month available.


History EU



The History EU measure allows you to analyze the **monthly dynamic** of one or more price series (which fall within the chosen product families). History EU contains the average prices calculated exclusively using European customs declarations, so as to present a **maximum degree of objectivity**.



Dispersion EU



The Dispersion EU measures allow you to analyze the monthly **prices' dispersion** of one or more price series (which fall within the chosen product families), in terms of minimum price (corresponding to the first quartile of the monthly price distribution), and maximum (corresponding to the third quartile of the distribution).

One subscription price

The *One* subscription (single commodity category) has a base price of 990€ + 410€ * Commodity Category + VAT.




1.3 One Plus

The *One Plus* subscription provides access to the sections of the PricePedia platform already described in the paragraph related to the *One* subscription.

In addition to what is already included in the *One* subscription, it includes the forecasts available in the **PricePedia Scenario** section related to the specific commodity categories of interest.

PricePedia Scenario



The PricePedia Scenario section allows you to monitor and analyze the 24month forecasts of price series related to the specific commodity categories of interest. The forecast scenario is updated monthly, incorporating all available market information.

One Plus subscription price

The One Plus subscription (single commodity category + forecasts) has a base price of 990€ + 1110€ * Commodity Category + VAT.



1.4 All

The *All* subscription provides access to the sections of the PricePedia platform already described for the *One* subscription and to **all available commodity categories**. It also grants access to:

• Tariffs (info regarding the existing tariff measures on EU imports)

Tariffs

The Tariffs section is accessible through the *Price Info* area and allows you to consult information related to tariff measures applicable to EU imports from various partner countries. For each product, if available, the following are indicated:

- base tariffs;
- preferential tariffs;
- specific interventions, such as controls and/or prohibitions;
- antidumping and/or countervailing measures;
- additional duties:
- possible application of the CBAM.

All subscription price

The All subscription (all commodity categories) has a base price of 2600€ + VAT.

1.5 All Plus

The All Plus subscription provides access to all sections of the PricePedia platform, including the PricePedia Scenario section, and to all available commodity categories.

All Plus subscription price

The All Plus subscription (all commodity categories and full access to the PricePedia Scenario) has a base price of **5200€** + **VAT**.

1.6 Enterprise

The *Enterprise* subscription provides full access to all sections of the PricePedia platform, including the PricePedia Scenario section, and to all available commodity categories. Additionally, it allows integrating all PricePedia datasets into your company's Information System (via API).

Enterprise subscription price

The *Enterprise* subscription (all commodity categories, full access to the PricePedia Scenario, and data integration into the company IS via API) has a base price of **6790€** + **VAT**.




2. Tools

Subscribing one of PricePedia subscriptions gives access to the following tools that are useful for the Procurement function:

- Should Cost Tool (to build a cost index)
- **Report** (to build a custom report with one or more product families of interest)

2.1 Should Cost Tool



The Should Cost tool allows you to build a cost index for a finished or semifinished product, starting from its cost determinants available in PricePedia and/or by uploading your own data in csv/excel format. Each determinant must be assigned a percentage of incidence on the total cost of the constructed product.

2.2 Report



The Report tool allows you to obtain a **graphical analysis report** (in PDF format) for the commodity categories of interest.

Access to this tool is available starting from the All subscription.



3. Additional services

The following additional services can be added to the PricePedia subscriptions:

- Additional users
- **Guest service** (linked to should cost)
- PricePedia data integration into the company information system via API(available only starting from All subscription)

3.1 Additional users

Each PricePedia subscription allows usage by a single user on a PC and a mobile device (tablet or smartphone). It is possible to associate **multiple additional users** with each subscription, who will have access to the same tools and datasets as the main account. All users associated with the subscription can access simultaneously without interrupting each other's sessions.

The price for each additional user is 120€ + VAT.

3.2 Guest service (linked to Should Cost)

It is possible to share your Should Cost analyses with clients and/or suppliers by activating the **Guest Service**. This service allows authorized guests to access the platform.

The service costs 350€ + VAT for activation, plus 75€ + VAT for each additional guest.

3.3 Data integration into the company IS via API

Through the PricePedia API, it is possible to integrate the platform's data directly into your company's information system. The service is included in the *Enterprise* subscription and is *on demand* for the *All* and *All Plus* subscriptions.

The price of the service is 1590€ + VAT.
